The Irish Cultural Grant was established in 1998 by resolution of the Board of Directors of Irish Festivals, Inc. A yearly total of \$2,000 is available, dispersed in smaller grant amounts.

Applications will be accepted between September 1<sup>st</sup> and October 31<sup>st</sup> and reviewed in November. The Scholarship Committee anticipates announcing grant recipients in November.

Its purpose is to fund an *individual's* project that is related to the study of any aspect of Irish culture. Applicant must be an individual, may be of any age or ethnic background and need not be a resident of the Milwaukee area.
