### **Enrollment and Fees**

Private lessons, group classes, samplers and workshops are offered for Irish music students of varying ability levels and ages. Most classes are taught by ear with some sheet music used.

45 minute small group classes (two or more students) are offered for \$18 per lesson. Private lessons in all instruments are subject to teacher availability. (Please check with instructor for private lesson rates.) There is also a \$12 administrative fee for each semester.


