HOW TO WRITE A LIMERICK

Read this sample limerick a few times. Note the rhythm and rhyme schemes.

To the Irish Fest grounds I did run (“A” end rhyme “un”)
da DUM da da DUM da da DUM - (3 “DUMS” or BEATS)

I took my wife to have fun (“A” end rhyme “un”)
da DUM da da DUM da da DUM- (3 “DUMS” or BEATS)

We drank and ate food (“B” end rhyme “ood”)
da da DUM da da DUM (2 “DUMS” or BEATS)

Which fueled our good mood (“B” end rhyme “ood”)
da da DUM da da DUM (2 “DUMS” or BEATS)

On Sunday we were sad it was done (“A” end rhyme “/un/”)
